The School Perceptions Student Engagement Survey™ is a 50 question survey designed to measure a student’s engagement in both their school work and school community.

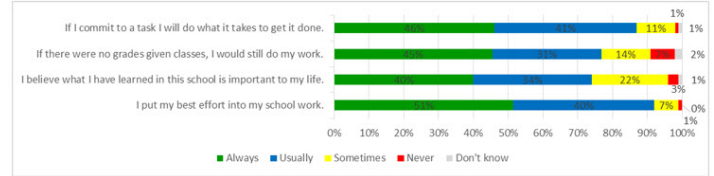
The goal in conducting the survey is to identify how a school district can best support each of their students to ensure their lifelong success upon high school graduation.
